## THE GERMAN SHEPHERD DOG CLUB OF CENTRAL OHIO, INC. MEETING WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 21, 2016

The meeting was called to order at 7:42 p.m. at lacono's Restaurant by president John Ayotte. There were eleven members and two guests present.

Minutes of the previous meetings were published in the newsletter. Charlotte LaRosa moved that reading of the minutes be dispensed with, seconded by Joyce Willis. The motion carried.

<u>Treasurer's Report:</u> Sue Clark gave the report. The treasury shows a profit of \$1,603.45 for the year to date. We have not received a check from the parent club for the futurity. Rosemary Booth moved the report be approved, seconded by Charlotte LaRosa. The motion passed.

<u>Training:</u> Annette Severance had thyroid surgery and is having complications and will not be able to conduct classes in the foreseeable future. No one else has agreed to conduct obedience training.

<u>Unfinished Business:</u> Agility trials are approved but decision needs to be made regarding awards to be presented at the trial. The premium list is being prepared with listing of prizes. Besides high in trial and high combined (all breeds), proposal was to offer high in trial and high combined German shepherd dog at each trial. Since entries are limited, priority should be given to German shepherd dog entries. Joyce Willis moved to approve the proposal, seconded by Rosemary Booth. The motion passed. The five-member committee to listed in the premium list are: John and Teri Ayotte, Dave and Charlotte Brugger, and Marcy Wright. All members are encouraged to attend and help at the trials.

<u>Election Of Officers and Board:</u> The list of officers and board for 2017 was provided to all members with the invitation to add nominees. There were no other names offered. Joe LaRosa moved the slate be accepted by acclamation, seconded by Joyce Willis. The motion carried.

<u>President's Report:</u> John Ayotte stated when the board reviews the standing rules at the October meeting, he would like to consider making a constitutional change to remove the item limiting new member applicants to only those with a German shepherd dog registered in their name. The secretary is to review AKC rules on the matter to be sure such a change is acceptable.

<u>New Business:</u> Two new members are eligible to be voted into membership: Marica Cherry and Steve White. They were excused from the meeting and vote was taken. Both were approved.

Training—conformation and informal obedience or rally—will commence as previously approved on Tuesday, October 18 and will be conducted every other week. Those participating are to prepay to cover half the cost of building rental with the club picking up remainder. John Ayotte will keep participants informed of changes/cancellation by text.

Charlotte LaRosa moved the meeting adjourn. Meeting was adjourned at 8:35.

#### G.S.D.C. OF CENTRAL OHIO, INC. BOARD MEETING WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 19, 2016

The meeting was called to order by president John Ayotte. Not present was Jon White. There were three guests in attendance.

Minutes of the September membership meeting were read. Charlotte LaRosa moved they be approved as read, seconded by Teri Ayotte. Minutes were approved.

Treasurer's Report: Sue Clark reported that the treasury is in good shape and we show a profit for this year. We've not received money from the Parent Club for the futurity show. Payment of insurance is due, and the price is the same as last year.

Secretary's Report: E-mail was received from Central Ohio Kennel Club confirming our supported entry for April 2017. They need the list of trophies we are giving by December 1. A list of our officers and key committee chairs was e-mailed to AKC following the September meeting. Contacted AKC regarding any restrictions to individuals joining a specialty club and was informed that ownership of an AKC registered dog is not required, but applicants are to encourage and promote quality in the breeding of purebred dogs and advance the interests of the breed by encouraging sportsmanlike competition in dog shows, obedience trials, tracking tests, and agility trials. Any other conditions provided in a club's constitution are left to the discretion of each individual club provided criteria as required by AKC is met. A copy of the proposed change in the constitution removing the requirement that applicants own an AKC registered dog in theirs or family member's name was e-mailed to all board members, and hard copies of constitution and current standing rules were mailed to the board.

Newsletter: Kathi Jo Zornes reported that our newsletter again won first place for its category at the National. She is working on the December newsletter.

Agility Trial: Marcy Wright stated that we need German shepherd entries on December 12 before the random draw. That will allow us to calculate trophies needed.

Old Business: The proposed change to the constitution was brought up for discussion. As a straw poll, guests were invited to voice their opinion. AKC urges clubs to accept and promote the approved breed standard by which dogs are judged and to encourage sportsmanship in competition in shows, obedience, tracking, and agility. There were questions if this will affect the integrity of the club. We have a code of ethics which sets the standard for members. An alternative mentioned is to create additional membership category in addition to regular member, associate member, junior member, and honorary member. Copies of the constitutional change will be sent to all members to review and will be read at the regular membership meeting then will be tabled and be presented for vote at the December dinner meeting.

Review Of Standing Rules: Kathi Jo Zornes mentioned a correction was needed under Business Item #3, to read Certificate Of Incorporation to be filed every five years and fee of \$25.00 (currently paid to the state). Under publicity Facebook should be added.

New Business: Christmas party and award dinner was discussed. The Rusty Bucket in Gahanna (same as last year) was chosen with tentative date of Monday, December 5 with Tuesday, December 6 an alternate.

November meeting will feature an educational presentation on canine first aid by Kathi Jo Zornes on Tuesday, November 15. Those working dogs can come at 6:30 p.m., and program will start at 7:30 p.m. There will be a short business meeting to follow.

Roy Clark moved the meeting adjourn. Meeting was adjourned at 8:55 p.m.

#### (CURRENT CONSTITUTION)

#### Article III - Membership

#### Section 1.

D. Junior Members shall be any minor, twelve (12) years of age or older, who owns, or whose parents own, a registered German Shepherd Dog. The parents shall have signed a "Responsibility Note" to the effect that they are responsible for all the actions of both child and dog during all Club activities. Such members shall not vote or hold office, but shall be entitled to all other privileges of the Club. Such membership fee shall be the same as the regular membership fee.

#### Section 2.

Eligibility, Application and Election of Members

A. To become a member the applicant, or a member of his immediate family must own a German Shepherd Dog registered in his or their own name with the American Kennel Club.

#### (PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL CHANGES)

#### **Article III - Membership**

#### Section 1

D. Junior Members shall be any minor, twelve (12) years of age or older, who pledges and whose parents pledge to support the objectives of the club as outlined in Article II, Section 1 of this Constitution. The parents shall have signed a "Responsibility Note" to the effect that they are responsible for all of the actions of the child and their dogs during all Club activities, Such members shall not vote or hold office, but shall be entitled to all other privileges of the Club. Dues for Junior Members shall be the same as the regular membership fee.


#### Section 2

A. To become a member the applicant must pledge to support the objectives of the club as outlined in Articles II, Section 1 of this Constitution.

#### Article II - Objectives

#### Section 1.

The objectives of the Club shall be to promote the adoption of the "Standard of the German Shepherd Dog" as approved by the American Kennel Club, by breeders, judges, dog show committees, and others as the recognized "Standard" by which this breed shall be judged; to protect, advance, and improve the interests of the breed by offering prizes, holding and supporting all events for which the club is eligible under the rules and regulations of the American Kennel Club, and in general to aid by every possible means in demonstrating its conspicuous abilities as Companion, War, Red Cross, Police, Herding and Lead Dog for the blind.

#### **Code of Sportsmanship**

The AKC would like to remind all clubs that sportsmanship is one of the hallmarks of dog sports. All our events are family friendly! Please post the AKC Code of Sportsmanship in as many locations as possible. Potential locations include the premium list, the judging program, the catalog, on ring number posts, and at the secretary or superintendents table. Help remind everyone that good sportsmanship is critical to the sport.

#### **Concurrent Specialties**

The Board of Directors approved a change to the entry limit for the specialty event. In the cases, where a specialty event is held over multiple days and one or more days of the specialty will be concurrent with an all-breed or group event, the entry limit for the specialty show is 100 entries each day. The entry limit for the all-breed or group event for the breed having a concurrent specialty remains 100 entries. #### **Junior Showmanship at Limited Breed Events**

For Limited Breed events held on or after January 1, 2017 clubs will have the option of offering Junior Showmanship classes for all AKC recognized breeds. Clubs will need to publish in their premium list if they are opening up Junior Showmanship to all AKC recognized breed or limiting it to the breeds in their group.

#### **Event Closeout Notices Now Delivered By Email**

As part of our continued effort to improve communication, Event Closeout Notices are now delivered by email to those clubs that have designated email as their primary form of communication. The Closeout Notice is generated after the completion of results processing for an event and it contains information about the following yearâ€<sup>TM</sup>s event. It is especially important for clubs to review the corresponded date of the following year's event.

The Class was taught by Club Member & AKC Ambassador Kathi Jo Zornes. Using her dog Beck for a demo, Kathi Jo showed attendees how to muzzle an injured dog using non-stick Coban, how to properly wrap a cut on a leg by starting low and moving upwards, and showed her own First Aid Kit for her dogs that she takes, explaining each item that the kit contained and how it could be used. Crowd interaction was encouraged and additional ideas were shared amongst the group during the session. A poly folder with a reproducible sheet to include all of a dog's medical information as well as step-by-step approach on how to give medications, carry/transport of an injured dog, treat for cuts, burns, injuries that involve impaling, handling & recognizing shock, key items to put in a dog first aid kit, & measurement conversions to simplify some medication doses were also provided. The group discussed some safe human medications & the top ten most dangerous medications humans have that dog's have ingested [taken from the ASPCA Poison Control website]. The program was concluded with cupcakes & cookies and well received by the attendees. Photos were posted to our Club Facebook wall, taken by Club President John Ayotte.

#### VETERANS JEREMY ANGENEND AND GERMAN SHEPHERD FITO REUNITED


Veteran's Day is just past, and The American Kennel Club honored two veterans—Jeremy Angenend and his K-9 partner Fito. This has a happy ending.

Jeremy Angenend and Fito began working together in 2008 training in the desert in California as a combat tracking team in the Marine Corp. Training was intense, but it built a trust between the two. Jeremy was hesitant to become attached to Fito due to their military role, but to Fito Jeremy was his best friend. After eighteen months of training, they were deployed in 2010 to Afghanistan. During the long flight to Afghanistan Jeremy slept next to Fito's kennel to calm his uneasiness from the unfamiliar sounds.

It is impossible for a dog and handler to work together for any length of time without forming an attachment. The two worked together to track down insurgents in Afghanistan and served for six months where their missions took them into the line of fire. While Jeremy would mentally assess everything, Fito would fall asleep almost immediately at his feet. During their deployment, their relationship changed, and Fito had become an emotional and calming support against the stresses of war.

Upon their return home, Jeremy learned that Fito would be sent to Texas to help train new handlers. With a marine's sense of duty Jeremy understood, but it was the hardest thing he had to bear as he was losing a friend when he needed him the most. In time, Jeremy accepted Fito's departure as he understood the mission in the military outweighs everything else. Jeremy Angenend's enlistment ended in 2012, and he moved on with his life and work, training with other dogs, but never forgetting his bond with Fito. In 2014, he received a life changing phone call: Fito was retiring and needed a home. Jeremy immediately agreed to bring him home.

This is Jeremy's description of their reunion. "My outstretched arms happily welcomed him as he barreled into my chest. I'm not certain how long I spent hugging him as he licked my face. It was one of those rare moments in life where time just seems to stop. I realized right then that time and separation couldn't weaken our relationship." They continue to live happily together as best friends.








## OGS AND THE HOLIDAYS




